

**ADAMS, John Headon (Jack)****Born:** England.

A London based garage proprietor, Jack was a well-known grass track rider who rode predominantly at tracks in the capital, including West Ham, Stamford Bridge, Wimbledon and Crystal Palace. At the end of the season he took part in an unsuccessful venture to establish the sport in Egypt and joined West Ham when league racing began in 1929. He was a regular in the side at the Custom House track that year and missed only a couple of meetings through the season and averaging around seven points per match. In 1930 Jack decided to concentrate on TT racing and was not seen in speedway again.
