

ADAMS, Peter

Born: Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire, England.

One of the leading junior riders in the Midlands during the Provincial League years, Peter began racing at his local Stoke track in 1960 and made his debut for the club by scoring five points against Newcastle at Sun Street in July, 1961 - his only league outing of the season. Thus began something of a pattern whereby Peter was given occasional outings in the 'Potters' side, often with impressive results, before losing his place to more experienced riders. In 1962 he had a run of four matches before the introduction of Eric Hockaday confined him to second half racing again and, after failing to win a regular place in 1963, he moved to Wolverhampton in mid-season. He was to play a minor role in the 'Wolves' Provincial League title win that year but opportunities at Monmore Green proved even harder to come by and Peter eventually called it a day after five years of effort to establish himself in a side.
