

ALDRIDGE, George Herbert

Born: May 16, 1931, Blackfield & Langley, Hampshire, England.*

George appeared at the California Training School in 1956 and was given a brief chance by Aldershot in the Southern Area League the following year. He rode in three mid-season matches for the 'Shots' but could only muster seven points before dropping out of the side. He had been a keen motorcyclist from his teenage years and worked at the local Esso factory, riding his Norton road bike to and from work. George retired from speedway in 1959 due to the lack of opportunities in the sport, but was a highly successful grass track rider, being rated in the top ten in the Southern Centre. He continued on the grass until 1964 when he suffered serious leg injuries in a track accident and was forced to quit.
