

ALEXANDER, John

Weeks after starting the sport in the summer of 1972 John had impressed Hackney boss Len Silver sufficiently to be awarded a junior contract. He was to ride just one official race in league speedway, appearing at number eight for Sunderland, also under the Len Silver banner, in their match at Long Eaton on August 31, 1972. He had finished in sixth place in the British Speedway Supporter's Club Junior Championship at King's Lynn a few days earlier – a meeting won by Keith White and also had second halves at Rayleigh where he helped out a short-handed Scunthorpe side. John continued to ride in the second half events at The Weir until early 1973 when he announced his retirement.
