

ANDREASEN, Preben

Born: September 7, 1944, Roskilde, Denmark.

When the Edinburgh 'Monarchs' hit a spell of injuries that decimated their side in the first season of the British League in 1965, promoter Ian Hoskins set out on a search to find urgent replacements. Finding that there was a reluctance amongst British riders to travel so far north on a weekly basis, the 'Monarchs' boss looked towards the Continent and signed the 20 year old Dane, Preben Andreasen. He made his debut for the club on July 31 against Hackney at Old Meadowbank but suffered a spill during the meeting, causing him to sustain a knee injury. He failed to score from three rides and had one further outing a week or so later at Newcastle, when he again failed to open his account for a composite team labelled 'The Vikings'. Finding that the knee injury was too painful to continue, Preben returned to Denmark and was not seen in British speedway again.
