

**ARCHER, William F. (Bill)**

**Born:** December 27, 1951, Orsett, Essex, England.

Bill switched from moto cross to speedway at the Hackney Training School in 1974 and joined Crayford when the club re-entered the league after a period of absence in 1975. He displaced Dave Howard in the 'Kestrels' side after just two meetings and held his team spot for the rest of the year, riding mainly at reserve. Paid nine at home to Ellesmere Port in mid-May was his best score of the year and he had another couple of decent scores in what was a healthy average of over four points per match. Bill was expected to push on to a second string role in 1976 but retired just two months into the new season citing domestic commitments as his reason for quitting.
