

ARGRAVE, George Palmer**Born:** November 14, 1912, Maidenhead, Berkshire, England.**Died:** 1974

George rode in non-league meetings at Oxford before the war and had trials at Harringay prior to joining Plymouth in the Third Division in 1947. He made his only official appearance for the 'Devils' in the Division Three fixture at Cradley Heath on July 26 where he failed to score from two rides, and was later on the books at Southampton and non-league Leicester in 1948, but did not make another league appearance.
