

ARNOLD, Philip (Phil)

Born: January 16, 1948, Bournemouth, Hampshire, England.*

A founder member of the Weymouth side in the British League Second Division in 1968, Phil missed just one of the 18 match league programme and was a popular, if not high scoring, member of the side at Radipole Lane. Six, paid seven, at Plymouth was his best effort of the campaign and he was destined to move to Pennycross the following year after the closure of Weymouth after just one season. A paid six score on his debut at home to the reigning champions Belle Vue 'Colts' was a promising start but he failed to score in the next meeting at Ipswich and did not appear again. Phil continued to ride in second half races at Poole for a time before retiring.
