

ATKINSON, Dennis

Born: 1910, Nelson, Lancashire, England.

Died: July 13, 1929

The elder brother of the World Finalist and England international, Arthur Atkinson, Dennis came from a motorcycling mad family who, despite their Lancashire roots, were based in Leeds where the brothers appeared for the local side in 1929. Whilst Arthur was in the side from the start, Dennis' progress was somewhat steadier but he forced his way into the team during the summer. After a handful of appearances in the English Dirt Track League, Dennis rode at Middlesbrough on July 12, 1929 and suffered head injuries in a track crash. He failed to recover from his injuries and died the following day, aged just 19.
