

BELLAMY, Les O. (Dick)

Born: England.

Dick was a London based rider who had a tyre dealership in Waddon in the south of the capital and had competed in path racing at Crystal Palace before the introduction of speedway. He rode at the opening meeting at the Palace track in 1928 and also competed in meetings at Wimbledon and Stamford Bridge before being named in the Stamford Bridge side for the opening of the Southern League season in 1929.

Dick rode in the first four meetings of the season and was unbeaten from two rides in each of the club's first two meetings – both massive 33-9 victories over London rivals, Lea Bridge and Wembley. After low scores in the two return fixtures, Dick was replaced in the side by the up and coming Wal Phillips and did not appear for the club again.
