

**BIGGS, Clifford John (Cliff)**

**Born:** February 12, 1928, Cradley Heath, West Midlands, England.\*

Cliff was a regular at Cradley Heath in the late 1940s, riding at winter training schools and having the occasional second half outing, but was unable to break into a strong side at the Dudley Wood circuit. His chance of competing in league racing came with the opening of the nearby Wolverhampton track in 1951 and he was one of many riders given the opportunity to make the grade at Monmore Green. Like most others however, Cliff was not afforded enough time to fully settle due to the general weakness of the side and rode just 17 times for the club. His best performance came in a rare home win against Cardiff in June when he scored seven, paid nine.
