

BIRD, Charles Leonard (Dicky)**Born:** 1909, Ilford, Essex, England**Died:** 1949

'Dicky' was born a short distance away from the High Beech track where the first speedway meeting was held in 1928 and appeared at that track in the first season of speedway, as well as the London tracks of Harringay and Lea Bridge. When the Southern League began in 1929, Dicky was in the first Harringay team to take to the track and scored three points on his debut at home to Lea Bridge. He rode a further two times for the club before leaving and joining White City later in the season, where he made a handful of appearances. 'Dicky' passed away in 1949 at the young age of 40.
