

BISHOP, Jeffrey Francis W. (Jeff)**Born:** March 20, 1925, Hereford, Herefordshire, England.***Died:** April, 2000.

A product of the Tiger Stevenson Training School, Jeff joined Wombwell in 1947 and spent two seasons as a member of the 'Colliers' side. By the time the track closed at the end of 1948 he was second only to Harwood Pike in the list of all time appearance makers at Station Road and was a steady second string or reserve, capable of the occasional high score. He toured South Africa in the winter of 1948-49, earning himself the wrath of the Speedway Control Board who had not sanctioned the trip. Although Jeff signed for Coventry on his return from South Africa, an off track injury and a Control Board suspension prevented him from ever making his 'Bees' debut.
