

BOGH, Ernst

Born: January 13, 1955, Holsted, Denmark.

The younger brother of Danish international Kurt Bogh, Ernst was signed by Leicester for the start of the 1976 season and started the year as part of a cosmopolitan 'Lions' side that also included a Finn, a Pole, a Norwegian and an Australian. The bottom end of the side was largely inexperienced and the club got off to a bad start with five defeats and two draws with Ernst being the first for the chop, eventually being replaced by Pepe Teromaa. Ernst had scored just four points from seven matches but was given a trial by another struggling British League side – Sheffield – only to be discarded after just two matches despite showing promising form for the Owlerton side.
