

BOOTH, Barry

Born: January 10, 1952, Manchester, Greater Manchester, England.

A former Belle Vue second half rider, Barry had outings at Crewe in 1972 but found much more success at Ellesmere Port the following season. It was not until the middle of May that he made his debut for the 'Gunners' but, once established, he was in the side for most of the rest of the season with a top score of nine, paid eleven, at home to Long Eaton the best of several decent scores. A promising career was interrupted when Barry had to temporarily give up the sport due to his commitments at work but he returned to the saddle at Thornton Road in 1975. He made 12 early season appearances for the club before losing his place and subsequently joined up with Coatbridge who were having problems staffing the lower end of their side. Barry did not have a successful time in Scotland and disappeared from the scene before the end of the year.
