

BOSHOFF, Toby

Born: circa 1927, Johannesburg, South Africa.

Died: February, 1992

Toby rode for South Africa in unofficial test matches against an English touring party early in 1949 and travelled with the tourists when they returned home for the start of the British season. He failed to impress during his one season in Britain, having spells at Division Three sides Rayleigh and Plymouth, and scoring only a handful of points. His best night came whilst riding for the 'Devils' when he scored eight points from three rides in a league match against Yarmouth at Pennycross. Toby continued to ride in his home country for some years and made international appearances for South Africa but never returned to British speedway.
