

BOSTON, Peter

Born: May 10, 1949, Hayling Island, Hampshire, England.

British born Peter emigrated to Australia at an early age and took up speedway at Perth. He was one of the tallest riders in the sport, reportedly measuring 6' 2", and his height and beard made him instantly recognisable. He returned to the U.K. in 1971 and joined Hull who had just joined the British League Second Division at their Boulevard home. Peter broke into the 'Vikings' side in August and had a top score of six points in the final home league match of the season against Birmingham. Although his scores were modest, he showed enough potential to be invited back in 1972 and had a solid first full season, averaging almost five points per match and twice being paid for double figures. A third season at The Boulevard showed little or no improvement on his previous scores and he did not return to the U.K. in 1974.
