

**BOTTOMS, Dennis Harold****Born:** July 26, 1921, Birmingham, West Midlands, England.\***Died:** October 5, 1982.

Harold was a motor cycle enthusiast who settled in Blackpool after marrying during the war. He began riding in 1947 at Oliver Hart's farm outside Wigan and had second half rides at Belle Vue and Fleetwood before signing for Hull in 1949. Harold made only one league appearance for the club, at Stoke on April 7, but continued to ride at Fleetwood for some years in second half events and in their non-league side of 1952. Known as Dennis outside speedway circles, he was a well-known figure in Blackpool, working as a physiotherapist in the town.
