

BOYCE, Alfred George (Alf)

Born: June 17, 1910, Liverpool, Merseyside, England.*

A former wall of death rider, Alf came into speedway at the end of the war at the relatively late age of 36. Given a team place by Southampton at the start of the 1947 season, he rode in the first league match of the year but made only intermittent appearances thereafter, scoring six points from five matches and dropping out altogether after riding at Wombwell in July.
