

## **BRADY, Alistair**

**Born:** January 15, 1949, Broxburn, Scotland.

Alistair took the plunge into Division One racing at the start of his career, breaking into the Coatbridge 'Monarchs' side in 1969 and having a decent run at the end of the season after coming through second half events at Cliftonhill. He scored nine points against Cradley Heath in the last match of the season but had to move across country to Glasgow in 1970 when Wembley took over the Coatbridge licence. Starting in the reserve berth at Hampden Park, Alistair had a real struggle to score points home or away and lost his place to Bill McMillan after just six matches.

A move to Berwick in Division Two was the ideal tonic and Alistair showed what he had learned in the previous few months with an eleven point score on his debut against Peterborough. His returns that season for the 'Bandits' were inconsistent but he was visiting many tracks for the first time and showed great improvement in 1971 when he averaged over seven points per match and provided excellent support to the heat leader trio of Doug Wyer, Maury Robinson and Andy Meldrum. This proved to be Alistair's best season as a run of injuries and poor form saw his scoring slump in 1972 and he retired the following year.
