

BRAGG, Basil (Bill)**Born:** 1900, Lambeth, London, England.**Died:** July, 1967

Bill took part in the early meetings at High Beech in 1928 and was also prominent at the London tracks, Stamford Bridge, White City, Wimbledon, West Ham and Crystal Palace. He was named in the starting line-up for Stamford Bridge's first ever league match in 1929 against Lea Bridge and was unbeaten from two rides in the second fixture at home to Wembley. However, it was not long before Bill lost his spot in the team and he disappeared from the side in June.
