

**BRETT, Alan Douglas**

**Born:** December 23, 1936, Kingston-upon-Thames, Surrey, England.\*

A former Wimbledon junior, Alan was a member of the Eastbourne side in the Southern Area League in 1955 whilst only 18 years of age, making him one of the youngest riders in the sport at that time. After a promising start to his career with the 'Eagles', Alan suffered a badly broken leg which kept him out of action for the rest of the season and the injury was so severe that it hindered his progress the following campaign, eventually forcing him to retire from the sport when he re-broke the leg in practice at the Arlington track in April 1957.
