Born: October 16, 1939, Tenterden, Kent, England.

One of the many up and coming riders used by the Canterbury promoter Johnnie Hoskins in the 'Crusaders' team in the early years of the British League Second Division, Neville was older than most of his counterparts, being nearly 30 years of age by the time he made his debut for the club in 1969. He had made his mark by winning the Stars of Tomorrow junior meeting at Kingsmead in May and was duly rewarded with a team place for the match against Doncaster at the end of the month. Neville was in and out of the side throughout the 1969 campaign and showed flashes of brilliance, including a ten point return against Plymouth at his home track. Neville disappeared from the scene at the end of that season and did not appear in league racing again.
