The brother of Cyril Bridges, Bill was a trainee at Rye House and also had second half rides at West Ham and Wimbledon. Thanks to his connections with the 'Hammers' and the fact that Arthur Atkinson was in charge at both tracks, Bill was named in the starting line-up for Rayleigh for the 1950 season and made his debut against Tamworth at The Weir. He was given just two outings in the side before losing his place to more experienced recruits.
