

BRIDGES, Cyril Francis

Born: May 26, 1925, Enfield, London, England.

An Enfield coal merchant, Cyril followed a similar career path to his brother Bill – graduating from the Rye House Training School to second half rides at Wimbledon and West Ham. He made just two appearances for Rayleigh after joining the club at the start of the 1950 season and was one of a number of riders tried out by Southampton in 1952 as the ‘Saints’ rebuilt their team for the Southern League after a period of inactivity. Cyril had just one outing at Bannister Court in which he failed to score and was not used by the club again.
