

BROCKBANK, David Thomas (Dave)

Born: July 19, 1947, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, England.*

Dave began his speedway career in 1967 at the Belle Vue Training School and he signed for the club after showing great promise in the sessions at the Hyde Road track. The 1968 season saw the club enter a team in the newly formed Second Division and the 'Colts' opened the historic venture in a home match against Canterbury on May 8. Dave scored three, paid four, in a solid start to the season but he broke his collarbone in the return match at Kingsmead ten days later, an injury which was to keep him out for much of the season. He returned to ride in the last match of the year but another pile-up at Belle Vue in 1969 saw him quit the sport with his marriage on the horizon.
