

CARRICK, Tommy

A second half rider at Brough Park, Newcastle, and mechanic to Wilf Jay, locally based Tommy was one of the smallest riders in the game - so much so that he was nicknamed 'Wee' Carrick. He was called upon to ride for Newcastle on two occasions in 1949, scoring one point in each home match, against Southampton in May and later, against Ashfield in September.
