

CASHMORE, James Henry (Jim)**Born:** March 11, 1909, Warwick, Warwickshire, England.***Died:** 2004.

Jim can count himself amongst the first Britons to have witnessed speedway, having been introduced to the sport as a 17 year old in 1926 whilst living in Auckland, New Zealand – two years before the first recognised U.K. speedway meeting at High Beech. Most of his racing days were spent on the grass tracks but Jim did appear in the Third Division in the post-war period, riding for Plymouth in 1947 and scoring 19 points for the Devon side in the first five matches of the season.
