

CHALLENGER, Reginald (Reg)

Born: June 6, 1908, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.*

Reg began riding speedway in 1925 but did not come to England until 22 years later, at the age of 38 - when most riders are thinking about retirement. Initially basing himself at Third Division Tamworth, he struggled for points until scoring seven at Wombwell and later secured a move to the South Yorkshire track that was more suited to his leg trailing style. He spent the rest of the season in and out of the 'Colliers' side and scored a total of 27 points during the year. Reg stayed in England until 1949, running a workshop in Sheffield, before returning to Australia with his Yorkshire born wife.
