Also programmed as Syd Chambers, he was a regular competitor at London tracks in 1928, predominantly Lea Bridge, Wimbledon and Harringay. He was named in the first ever Wimbledon side to race in a league meeting when he took part in the Southern League fixture at Crystal Palace and held his place for the first five matches. When the rules regarding star riders competing in league matches were relaxed and men like Cecil Brown and Jim Kempster were free to ride for the Plough Lane club, Sid lost his place and didn't appear again after June 1929.
