

CHIPMAN, Howard

Born: December 29, 1918, Fazeley, Staffordshire, England.*

Died: May, 2000.

A pre-war road racer, Howard also competed in grass track events before turning to speedway at his local track at Tamworth after the war had ended. He forced his way into the team at the Fazeley Stadium towards the end of 1948 and was a popular if not high scoring member of the side - a reserves paid maximum against Hull at his home track being his best effort. He was given a starting place in 1949 as he tried to win a regular spot in the side but a badly broken leg in a crash with Ted Gibson sustained at Plymouth in May ended his career.
