

CLAYTON, Hubert (Bert)

Bert was a Huddersfield based rider who competed in the first meeting at Audenshaw on March 3 1928, and also competed at his home town track and at Halifax's Thrum Hall. When the English Dirt-Track League was established in 1929 he was part of the Halifax side for their first meeting at Barnsley on May 4. He was in and out of the side throughout the season and displayed some excellent form in spells, including an unbeaten paid nine score from three rides in the home meeting against Newcastle. Halifax pulled out of the league before the following season and Bert was not seen in league action again.
