When speedway came to Sheffield in 1929 a host of local men with experience of motor-cycling tried their luck at the Owlerton track. George, nicknamed 'Clip' was 21 years of age when he made his debut for the club at Halifax on June 13 and rode in four consecutive fixtures before missing out for six weeks. He returned to the side in the middle of August but was not part of the set-up the following year.
