

CREASOR, Fred

Born: April 3, 1900, Middlesbrough, Cleveland, England.

Died: 1979

The elder of the two racing Creasor brothers from Middlesbrough, Fred rode at his local Cleveland Park track in 1928 but when league racing was introduced the following year, Fred was in the colours of local rivals, Newcastle. His first league match for the club was at home to Halifax and Fred was unbeaten by an opponent in three rides as Newcastle opened with a healthy 37-23 win over their rivals from West Yorkshire. Three weeks later he scored a full maximum at Middlesbrough as his home town team were demolished at Cleveland Park but occasional maximums were also interspersed with some low points returns which kept his average down to between six and seven points per match. Fred spent just two seasons in the sport and decided not to compete in the 1930 league campaign.
