

## **CREE, Bingley**

**Born:** June 27, 1914, Sidmouth, Devon, England.\*

**Died:** May 31, 2011

A well-known figure on the grass track circuits of the south west of England, Bingley rode from 1929 up until the outbreak of war ten years later. After working in the aircraft industry during the hostilities, he resumed his career on the grass and made occasional speedway appearances for Poole in the Third Division in 1948.

However, he disliked the more regimented and organised nature of speedway and decided against pursuing a full time career in the sport. Bingley emigrated to Canada in 1951 and competed in occasional speedway events after settling in North America.
