From Finchley in North London, Billy rode in the first ever speedway meetings at High Beech on the first day of the sport in the U.K and later had a short spell in the Stamford Bridge Southern League side in 1929. He was unbeaten from three rides in the massive 53-10 home win over Harringay in July but hardly ever featured for the eventual league winners. Billy later became a respected referee.
