

## DEEGAN, Bill

**Born:** England.

Renowned for forming the famous 'Hell's Angels' motorcycle stunt team, Bill also dabbled at speedway and made his post-war debut for Middlesbrough in 1946. He spent only a short time at Cleveland Park but became one of Plymouth's first signings the following year when they opened their doors to Third Division racing. Bill rode in the 'Devils' first seven matches of the season, scoring 20 points before losing his team place. He made an unsuccessful return to the sport at the California track in Berkshire in 1955 despite kitting himself out with new equipment.
