

**ELLIOTT, Alfred Frederick (Alf)****Born:** January 27, 1915, Bristol, Avon, England.\***Died:** 1996.

Alf was a pre-war grass track rider who was discovered at the Rye House Training School in 1945 and joined Sheffield when league racing resumed the following year. He lost his team place at Owlerton after a run of poor scores and signed for Wombwell during the 1947 season where he added strength to a struggling 'Colliers' side. He later had a successful, if injury hit, spell with Poole in 1948 before being signed by the newly formed Oxford 'Cheetahs' in the Third Division of 1949. Alf struggled to find the form he had shown at Wimborne Road the previous year and retired in July, although he stayed involved in the sport and gained recognition for being a fine track designer and curator.
