

**FERGUSON, Joseph (Joe)****Born:** September 23, 1917, Kilmarnock, Scotland.\***Died:** 1982.

Joe was a Merchant Navy Officer and Dunkirk veteran who tried his hand at speedway in 1949, having witnessed the sport in Australia some years earlier. He bought a bike from 'Buck' Ryan and largely treated the sport as a hobby, working on a whaling boat to help fund his racing. He made some end of season appearances for Glasgow in 1949, but failed to open his point scoring account in five matches. He did, however, put in some impressive performances whilst riding for non-league Motherwell in 1950.
