Charlie hailed from South Australia and arrived at Barnsley in June 1929. He made an immediate impression at the Lundwood track, beating local hero Bert Round and the formidable Oliver Langton to win the Barnsley Golden Helmet on his debut at the track. He made his league debut shortly afterwards and was impressive in winning two of his three rides but is thought to have been injured early into his spell in South Yorkshire and disappeared from the side.
