

## **HAMLEY, 'Red'**

**Born:** Lancashire, England.

Lancastrian 'Red' began the 1946 season on the terraces at Odsal but soon got the urge to ride and broke into the Bradford team later that season after purchasing a bike of his own. He made his debut in a National Trophy match at Sheffield in July but six appearances that season yielded only seven points and it was at Division Three side Wombwell that 'Red' found most of his success. A popular team member at Station Road, he disappeared from the racing scene when the club closed its doors at the end of 1948 after scoring over 250 points for the 'Colliers' in two seasons.
