

HAYLES, Johnnie

Born: England.

A member of the Hastings side of 1948, Johnnie made his debut for the 'Saxons' at home to Cradley Heath on July 28, and went on to make six further appearances for the Sussex side. He had a top score of seven from three rides against Hull at the Pilot Field Stadium at the start of September but failed to score in his next two meetings and did not ride for the club again. Although he never appeared in British League speedway after his spell at Hastings, Johnnie was one of a number of riders to take part in meetings in Spain in 1949 and rode at the Dunmore track in Belfast in 1950.
