

## HIEATT, Bernard Lawrence (Bern)

**Born:** 1909, Witney, Oxfordshire, England.

**Died:** 1930

Bern rode in meetings at Camberley in 1927 which were billed as dirt-track but were actually sand racing meetings held in a clockwise direction. He rode at various tracks in 1928 including the Gorse Hill track at Swindon and London circuits Wimbledon and White City in the first year of speedway in the U.K. and turned out for Wembley in 1929 after going to Egypt to race with a group of riders at the end of the previous season. His appearances were brief and he was not a regular member of the side at the Empire Stadium. Bern died at the young age of 21.
