

HOLE, Graham Aubrey

Born: April 7, 1921, Bath, Avon, England.*

Died: February, 1988.

The middle of the trio of racing Hole brothers, Graham was the least known and made just 16 official appearances for Bristol over a three year period. He made his debut in the 'Bulldogs' first post-war league match at Middlesbrough in April 1947 but appeared on just one further occasion that year. He was never able to claim a regular team place and played only a minor role in the club's Second Division championship successes of 1948 and 1949.
