

HOOD, Arthur

Born: Rochester, Kent, England.

A grass track rider of some renown on the circuits of Kent and the south east, Arthur appeared at the training school run by the Speedway World magazine in 1948 and made good progress at Eastbourne. He joined Hastings for the 1949 season but opportunities for regular league action were rare and he was not helped by having to serve a suspension for an incident at a 1948 grass track meeting at Brands Hatch. He later rode in non-league challenge matches for Eastbourne in 1950 but did not appear in official fixtures again.
