

HYNES, David (Dave)

Born: November 2, 1914, Echuca, Victoria, Australia.

Hailing from Victoria, Australia, Dave was a useful speedway rider but also an expert frame builder with a large client list comprising of many of the world's leading riders. He rode briefly in the U.S.A with Bill Maddern and Cliff Watson and tried his luck in England with Plymouth in 1948. He scored seven points on his 'Devils' debut and followed this up with impressive scores of paid eleven and paid eight, but an increasing list of orders for frames saw him drop out of the riding side of the sport. Later basing himself at the Birmingham workshops, he was almost called upon to ride for the 'Brummies' during an injury crisis, but contracted flu and missed out on his chance. Dave made one appearance for his country on December 6, 1947 against England at Brisbane.
