

JERVIS, Hubert Cyril (Hugh)

Born: 1906, Coventry, Warwickshire, England.

The younger brother of England international Arthur Jervis, Hugh followed his brother into the sport and broke into the Manchester White City side, where Arthur was a heat leader, in 1929. He did not secure a regular place in the powerhouse side but was looking to establish himself when he lost two fingers in a track crash towards the end of the season and was forced to retire from the sport.
