

LLOYD, John P. (Jack)

Jack was one of the stars of the Hall Green side when Southern League racing was introduced to the Birmingham track in 1929. He had competed at the Midlands circuits the previous year and made an immediate impression in team racing, dropping just three points in five meetings before the club withdrew from the competition. He was forced to move across the city to Perry Barr but disappeared from the scene after just a handful of meetings for his new club.
