A post-war junior who had competed at war time meetings at Rye House, Jack was one of the many riders used by Plymouth in 1947 as they attempted to escape the lower reaches of Division Three. His progress was not helped after he suffered concussion in the first meeting at Pennycross and he was used only sparingly by the 'Devils' despite some promising performances, including a top score of six at Eastbourne in September.
