

**MUDGWAY, George Neville**

**Born:** August 21, 1918, Taumarunui, New Zealand.

A New Zealander reputed to be of Maori descent, George was signed by Bradford in 1947 and had a spell at reserve in the 'Boomerangs' line up. He found Division One racing a little tough in his only season in Britain and was able to record just ten points from eight matches in top flight racing. He also spent a short spell with Middlesbrough but did not make an official appearance for the Cleveland Park side. Although he returned home at the end of the season, George did continue to ride at the Auckland track until 1950 when a persistent leg injury caused him to quit.
